

Emergency Exercise Concepts Workshops for Health Care Partners

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) Emergency Preparedness Rule requires covered entities to conduct a facilitated tabletop exercise and a “whole community” functional exercise each year. Fulfilling this requirement is challenging for many organizations.

The Granite State Health Care Coalition (GSHCC), an initiative of the Foundation for Healthy Communities, invites organizations covered by the CMS EP Rule to come and learn the basics of exercise design and implementation.
