Position Description

Title: Director, Provider Engagement

Reports to: Executive Director

Job Summary: The Director of Provider Engagement will lead a grant funded project to support health care providers with the emerging market of regenerative medicine technologies and biofabrication products. The position will work with clinical providers in New Hampshire to assess their knowledge, beliefs, skills and concerns related to regeneration medicine. The Director will use analysis to develop and implement a strategic plan for provider education and support. The Director will work closely with ReGen Valley, the regional federal Tech Hub, and Franklin Pierce University.

FLSA Status: Full-time/Exempt/Salaried

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- The Director will assess the knowledge, attitudes, beliefs and concerns of providers in relation to the use of regeneration medicine
- The Director will develop a strategic plan, designed to improve provider understanding and confidence of regeneration medicine products
- Establish and build strategic relationships with ReGen Valley Consortium members and serve as an active member of the group
- Partner with other provider serving organizations and member associations on outreach efforts across the state
- The Director will assess the knowledge, attitudes, beliefs and concerns of patients and families in relation to the use of regeneration medicine
- Provide technical assistance and support to partner organizations to improve their knowledge of regenerative medicine
- Public speaking at community events, conferences and media opportunities

Required Skills/Abilities:

- Experience working in a clinical health setting
- Experience in community engagement, education and outreach
- Experience conducting market analysis
- Familiarity with the New Hampshire health care environment
- Strong customer service and communication skills
- Ability to work independently, while maintaining connections to a broader staff team

- A commitment to health equity

Education and Experience:

- Bachelor's degree in a health-related field
- 5 years' experience in health care

Physical Requirements:

- Prolonged periods of sitting at a desk and working on a computer
- Must be able to drive a motor vehicle for frequent in-state travel
- Occasional support of office environment could include lifting up to 20 pounds, ascending/descending ladders and moving equipment
- Setting up/breaking down for community tabling events

Travel Requirements:

- Frequent in-state travel is required, including occasional overnight trips. Out-of-state travel may be required several times a year for training
- Valid driver's license required
