What is the GSHCC?

The Granite State Health Care Coalition is a network of representatives from public and private organizations from across the healthcare and public health landscape in New Hampshire. The GSHCC assists healthcare and public health partners in preparing for, responding to, and recovering from events impacting the health care system in New Hampshire. The GSHCC serves as a support to ESF-8 through preparedness, response, and recovery efforts, including in response to planned and real-world events.
